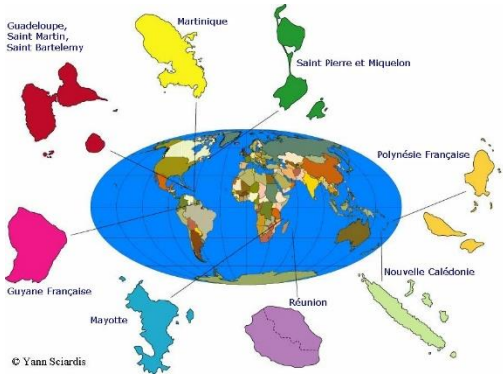

La 2^e vie des équipements électriques = the second life of electrical equipment



French territory covers mainland France, overseas departments and collectivities.

- However, not all overseas departments and collectivities fall within the scope of the WEEE regulation.
- The chart below specifies for each overseas department and collectivity whether it is included in the WEEE regulation.



The producer is the person who puts the EEE on the French market for the first time.

A company who introduces EEE from the mainland in Guadeloupe is not a producer.

However, a company importing EEE from the USA to Guadeloupe is a producer.

In the waste sector, the producer is the person who places the equipment on the French market regardless of the specific VAT system of some overseas departments.

NB:

The regulation does not apply to Monaco.



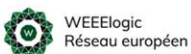
